



LWWC Re-Opening Plan

We eagerly look forward to being able to gather again for worship and celebration of our Savior. As we welcome our community to join us in our gatherings, we have prepared a multi-step process to guide us through the transition toward a full and free engagement in our mission to share the love and grace of Jesus to our world.

Our highest priority is to make sure that as we seek to nurture the spiritual health of all who participate in our services and activities, we must not rush in at the expense of careful and thoughtful measures to protect that physical health and safety of everyone, including staff, leaders, volunteers, and attendees. With this focus in mind, and after much prayer, research, and thought, we have established the following 3 Phase plan for safely reintroducing in-person gatherings and activities at Living Water Wesleyan Church.

The Apostle Paul exhorts us in Philippians 2:3,
“Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also the the interests of others.”

As you consider joining us for any Worship Service or Discipleship Group, please adhere to these guidelines for the protection of everyone, rather than just in consideration of personal preference and comfort.

If you do not feel well or if you are experiencing any symptoms of respiratory illness (cold, flu, bronchitis, etc .), please stay home. You will still be able to join the service as it is live-streamed over the Internet. (www.lwwc.net)

PHASE 1 (Possibly in late May or Early June)

Worship Services

“Touchless Worship”

Main Entry/Exit Doors held open. No commonly shared or touched items.

Face masks

Required for all indoor gatherings

Temperature Checked on entry

No entry if temperature above 100.2 degrees

Hand sensitization on entry

Limited Seating/Social Distancing

Likely 2 Sunday AM services- To Be Determined, possibly by age-group

No-contact greetings.

No physical contact

No Children's Worship-

We will offer a children's message during the service if children are present.

BYO- Bring Your Own

Offering envelopes Sermon note outline will be available to download and print on our website.

No hospitality

Coffee, Snacks, Bottled Water, etc. No church fellowship meals or outings.

Discipleship Groups (Sunday School, Bible Studies, Youth, etc.)

Less than 15 with 6' Social Distancing

Face Masks

Required only if meeting indoors

No hand-outs

No passed class materials

Lecture style Seating

Row Seating only. No tables or chairs set for face-to-face seating

No-Contact Greeting

No physical contact

No hospitality

Coffee, Snacks, Bottled Water, etc.

PHASE 2 (As conditions permit- Significant reduction in COVID 19 infections)

Worship Services

“Touch-limited Worship”

Main Entry/Exit Doors not held open. No commonly shared or touched items.

Face masks optional

Recommended for those over age 60

Hand sensitization on entry

Limited Seating/Social Distancing

Likely 2 Sunday AM services- To Be Determined, all age-groups inclusive

No-contact greetings.

No physical contact

No Children's Worship

We will offer a children's message during the service if children are present.

BYO- Bring Your Own

Offering envelopes and Sermon notes.

Sermon note outline will be available to download and print on our website.

No hospitality

Coffee, Snacks, Bottled Water, etc. No church Fellowship meals or outings.

Discipleship Groups (Sunday School, Bible Studies, Youth, etc.)

Less than 25 with 6' Social Distancing

Face Masks

Required only if meeting indoors

Leader provided study hand-outs

No shared class materials

Lecture style Seating

Row Seating only. No tables or chairs set for face-to-face seating

No-Contact Greeting

No physical contact

No hospitality

Coffee, Snacks, Bottled Water, etc.

PHASE 3 (As conditions permit- Minimal rate of new COVID 19 infections)

Worship Services

“Touch-limited Worship”

Main Entry/Exit Doors not held open.

Face masks optional

Recommended for those over age 60

Hands sanitized on entry

Open Seating

1 Sunday AM service- multi-generational. No reservations. Yeah!

Low-contact greetings.

No hand-to-hand-contact or hugs.

Children's Worship

No Senior citizens over 60 assisting

Limited interactions and minimal hands-on activities and manipulatives.

Church provided resources

Offering envelopes and Bulletins, etc. Pick up your own

Sermon note outline will remain available to download and print from our website.

Served hospitality

No self-serve hospitality. We will serve you!

Coffee, Snacks, Bottled Water, etc.

Designated volunteer servers as needed.

Outdoors fellowship meals (cafeteria style, servers required)

Discipleship Groups (Sunday School, Bible Studies, Youth, etc.)

Any size with Open Seating

Face Masks

Required only if meeting indoors

Leader provided study hand-outs

No shared class materials

Lecture style Seating

Row Seating only. No tables or chairs set for face-to-face seating

Low-contact greetings.

No hand-to-hand-contact or hugs.

Served hospitality

1 designated person will serve any Coffee, Snacks, Bottled Water, etc.

PHASE 4- Our New Normal (Near normal negligible infection threat)

Common sense personal precautions (Hand sanitizer remains available)

No limits to groups size, seating arrangements, or participation

Limited physical contact greetings (by consent only!)

Self-serve hospitality

Please dispose of whatever supplies, napkins, plates, or utensils you touch.

Cafeteria style served food. But self-serve drinks and deserts.

Pray with us as we move to resume in-person gatherings and activities. We miss our church family and eagerly look forward to being together in worship, service, and fellowship as a church family.
